WHEN A CHILD GOES MISSING:

- 1 Don't wait 24 hours!
- 2 Complete a SAPS 55 form at your nearest police station.
- 3 Contact MCSA on **072 647 7464**.

- 4 Send the following information:
 - name of the missing child
 - age of the missing child
 - situation surrounding the missing child
 - case number
 - SAPS details (including the name of the officer that assisted you)
 - most recent photo of missing child
 - via email: info@missingchildren.org.za
 - of fax: 0860 580 3310

MCSA will distribute case-related information to the province and even nationally, if necessary. MCSA will keep both the family of the missing child and the SAPS up to date on any relevant information and leads.

- 5 Keep MCSA updated on progress.
